Overview

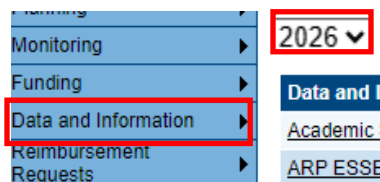
T.C.A § 49-6-1021 requires the department of education to report annually compliance data related to physical activity and physical education requirements.

Compliance report in ePlan

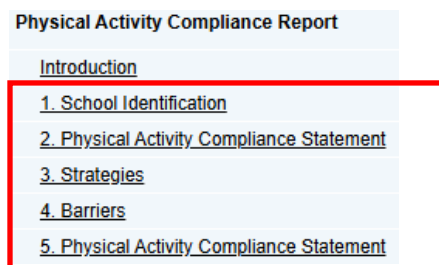
The report will open in ePlan on **Monday, January 26, 2026**, and must be completed by **Friday, February 27, 2026**. School Principals will have access to submit their data.

Instructions

Step 1: Data and Information > 2026 > Physical Activity Compliance Report



Step 2: Read the **Introduction**, then complete all five pages of the **Compliance Report** for your school.



***Davidson County, Hamilton County, Knox County and Memphis-Shelby County ONLY:** Schools are listed alphabetically. Top pages accommodate A-F. Additional pages accommodate the remainder of schools and are appropriately labeled. Each school still only has five pages to complete.

Notes for Completing the Compliance Report:

1. Complete all five pages for your school.
2. Most districts will have multiple schools listed. Ensure you are entering your responses for the appropriate school on each page.
3. Your entry auto-saves when you go to the next page.
4. DO NOT attempt to change the report status to "draft complete". A district-level employee has been designated to complete this.
