### Accounting for Education Technology

- Category—72250
- Budget and account for technology infrastructure expenditures.
- Category established in FY18 to isolate and understand the costs of education technology
- To properly divide costs between direct and indirect to calculate indirect cost rates.



# What costs and object codes to report in 72250

- Salaries and benefits of Technology Workers
  - Tech Coordinator (105)
  - Programmers (120)
  - Data Processing Personnel (121)
  - All personnel managing the network and working to support the technology infrastructure that delivers technology solutions to everyone, including staff, teachers, and students.
  - Include those personnel who repair hardware and are desktop/device troubleshooters
    - Report salaries from object code 189 if they fit above criteria.

# What costs and object codes to report in 72250

- Continued...
- Contracts for services to manage technology (336 or 399)

• Payments to deliver internet connection (350)



What costs to report as education technology vs. instructional technology

**Software Purchases:** 

Account for software (471) <u>in the category that</u> receives the benefit.

instructional software—use 71100

finance software—use 72510

Network management software—use 72250

**Equipment Purchases:** 

Account for equipment (79X) in the category that receives the benefit.

Student laptops—use 71100 Supervisor of regular instruction—use 72210 Network Server



# What cost to report as educational technology vs. instructional technology

- **Instructional computer personnel (138):**
- Since this is a teacher providing instruction, in a computer class or other technology, to students code to 71100-138.
  Certified personnel working with other teachers on instructional technology strategies—code to 72210-138.
  Object code 138 is not available in 72250.
