1.5 Prayer Certification

The constitutionally protected prayer certification is required as a condition of receiving funds under ESSA. Each LEA must certify, in writing, to the Tennessee Department of Education (department) that no policy of the LEA prevents, or otherwise denies participation in, constitutionally protected prayer in public elementary and secondary schools. The LEA is required to report instances if they have occurred.

Required Deadlines:

• Oct. 1: Prayer Certification completed in ePlan under Data and Information.
