Purchasing Education Technology & Services	 Devices and equipment (computers, laptops, tablets) for students and teachers Supplemental equipment or accessories (i.e., monitors, headsets, web cameras) for online instruction Software applications and digital platforms or licenses for their use Digital instruction programs and curriculum Devices and equipment (i.e., hot spots) to provide internet access for students who do not have access at home and subscriptions for connectivity Technology support and training for parents and guardians Cabling and technology infrastructure at the school building Information Technology services (i.e., software and hardware troubleshooting, technical support, and device management services)
Providing Individual Instructional Materials, Textbooks & Packets	 Materials, printing, and copying costs associated with mailing learning packets to students Books and textbooks for each student Postage for mailing any of the foregoing to students Lamination and other protection for instructional materials
Providing Professional Development and Training for Teachers on Remote Instruction and New Modes of In- Person Instruction	 Training on how to use online learning platforms Professional development related to distance learning: vendors, courses, materials, and/or stipends for teacher participation Professional development related to distance learning for supporting students with disabilities Professional development related to distance learning for supporting English learners Professional development on mental health services Behavior support strategies for online environments Developing feedback mechanisms to improve working conditions Helping school personnel have meaningful interactions with students during school closures Relationship-building skills and effective communication strategies
Making Materials Available for Students with Disabilities or English Learners	 Services and activities to address the unique needs of children with disabilities, including how services can be delivered that will meet their needs Planning and coordinating activities, and providing guidance for implementing IDEA services Virtual instructional tools and resources designed to support English language development

Purchasing Cleaning Supplies and Services and PPE	 Wipes, hand sanitizers, disinfectants Additional general cleaning supplies needed for more frequent cleaning Sanitation stations Masks, gloves Plexiglass barriers Cleaning services Waste disposal services Other sanitation services Hiring additional cleaning/maintenance personnel
Improving Facilities in Order to Make Them Safe for Staff and Students	 HVAC filters and systems Room dividers Structural repairs Plumbing Electrical Flooring
Hiring Nurses and/or Additional Bus Drivers	 Positions such as extra nurses, interventionists, support staff for remediation services, and staff who provide supports during after school or extended hours Bus drivers to run additional or alternative routes and the associated transportation costs Barriers and other methods for retrofitting buses for social distancing
Providing Additional Supports for Students	 Counseling and mental health supports Instructional support services for summer engagement Planning and implementing activities related to supplemental tutoring
