

## Epidemiology and Laboratory Capacity (ELC) Grant Opportunity

The ELC COVID Testing Grant is intended to support the reopening and in-person instruction of K-12 schools through supporting comprehensive screening testing for K-12 schools (public, including charter schools, and non-public). Initial testing could begin by late spring 2021 and extend through summer programming in 2022, as funds allow. ELC grant funds will be awarded May 2021 and expire July 31, 2022.

### The ELC Grant requires:

1. Rapid deployment of screening testing resources for the current and subsequent school year.
2. Weekly data reporting (number of tests, test type, cases identified).
3. Development of K-12 screening testing implementation plan.
4. Implementation of screening testing action plan for the following school year.

### ELC Grant options for LEAs and Non-Public Schools:

- **Nurses:** salary, benefits, over-time, and supplies for nurses (FTEs or contracted support) to administer on-demand testing
- **Updates or modifications to testing centers** (which could include school-based nurse/health rooms, district health spaces, Family Resource Centers, etc.)
- **Existing mass testing programs or strategies**

### Allowable Use of Funds

Nurses: Salaries, benefits, or contract costs	Minor construction - e.g., resurfacing parking lots for safer testing locations, storage facilities, minor building improvements, etc. for test centers
Travel (reimbursed at \$0.47 a mile) - e.g., CO to school sites, nurses to school sites	Costs associated with operating alternate/pop-up testing sites
Contracts with academic institutions, private laboratories, other healthcare entities to process any test kits	Costs for running mass testing programs (including pooling, pop-up sites, or similar)
Supplies and Equipment for Testing: Testing kits, PPE, collection supplies, etc.	Shipping/Postage/Printing/Duplicating
