Providing Direct Services and Supports for Students with Disabilities (SWDs)	 Providing compensatory services based on IEP team decisions Providing support and direct services for students with disabilities (SWDs) Providing professional development to special education staff Providing extended school year (ESY) services as determined on an individual basis by a child's Individualized Educational Plan (IEP) Team to be necessary to provide free appropriate public education (FAPE) Providing positive behavioral interventions and supports (PBIS) and mental health services for children with disabilities Assisting local educational agencies (LEAs) in meeting personnel shortages including by hiring additional personnel to provide special education and related services and reducing caseloads in key areas Supporting capacity-building activities and improving the delivery of services by LEAs to improve results for SWDs
Implementing Child Find	 Implementing child find policies and procedures Alleviating evaluation backlogs
Technology Accessibility for SWDs	 Improving the use of technology in the classroom and/or in a remote setting for SWDs to enhance learning Supporting the use of technology, including technology with universal design principles and assistive technology devices, to maximize accessibility to the general education curriculum
Improving Transition Services for SWDs	• Implementing transition programs, including coordination of services with agencies involved in supporting the transition of SWDs to postsecondary activities
Providing for High- Cost Students	 Increasing the number of high-need SWDs funded under a State's high- cost fund
Additional Programming Placement Needs	• Developing programming for SWDs who have been expelled from school, in correctional facilities, enrolled in State-operated or State-supported schools, and SWDs in charter schools
