

Data Definitions and Sources for the 2021-22 Civil Rights Data Collection (CRDC)

The U.S. Department of Education's Office of Civil Rights (OCR) collects civil rights data from local educational agencies (LEAs) biennially. The next civil rights data collection (CRDC) is scheduled for December 2023 – February 2024 for data from the 2021-22 school year. Although LEAs use their student information systems (SIS) to prepare and submit their responses, the education information system (EIS) data definitions and sources provided below might be helpful to LEAs and SIS vendors as they prepare their submissions for the 2021-22 collection. The data definitions and sources fall into four categories: key subgroups, disciplinary actions, disciplinary offenses, and justice facilities and are presented in that order.

Harassment or Bullying – Sex	Intimidation or abusive behavior to a student based on actual or perceived sex (43) includes sexual harassment and harassment or bullying based on sex stereotyping. Sexual harassment is unwelcome conduct of a sexual nature, such as unwelcome sexual advances, requests for sexual favors, and other verbal, nonverbal, or physical conduct of a sexual nature. Harassment or bullying based on sex stereotyping includes acts of verbal, nonverbal, or physical aggression, intimidation, or hostility based on sex or sex stereotyping, but not involving conduct of a sexual nature. Both male and female students can be victims of harassment or bullying on the basis of sex, and the harasser or bully and the victim can be of the same sex.
