Grant Reviewer – Conflict of Interest Statement

The Tennessee Department of Education is committed to ensuring a fair, equitable, and transparent review process of the McKinney-Vento subgrant. As a potential grant reviewer, please review the following examples of possible conflicts of interest to determine your eligibility to participate in the grant application review process.

1. Your affiliation with an applicant agency- A conflict may exist if you or an immediate family member(s) are:
 - a. currently employed in any capacity with the applicant agency;
 - b. currently employed in any capacity with an existing Tennessee McKinney-Vento subgrantee;
 - c. previously employed with the applicant agency within the last 12 months;
 - d. previously employed with an existing Tennessee McKinney-Vento subgrantee within the last 12 months;
 - e. being considered for employment with the applicant agency;
 - f. re-employed through a formal or informal agreement with the applicant agency; or
 - g. a member of the board or relevant committee of the applicant agency.
2. Your relationship with a person who has a personal interest in the proposal or other application- A conflict of interest may exist if you have a:
 - a. known family relationship such as a spouse, child, sibling, or parent;
 - b. business or professional partnership; or
 - c. close personal friendship that might affect your ability to review the application objectively.
